

Criteria for Inclusion into Title 1 Program in Hendricks Public School for the School Year 2017-2018

1. All students in HPS will be analyzed according to their test scores in any or all of the below listed tests:
For students in Grades K-2, the Iowa Basic scores will be used.
For students in Grades 3-12, MCA, OLPA and Star Reading and Math scores will be used. Any students who achieve a score of “Not Meeting” or “Partially Meeting” the standards will be eligible. Students whose scores are in the “Meet” range, but in the bottom 25% of that category, or whose scores do not remain in the “Meet” range for three consecutive test sessions, but go back and forth to lower categories (Partially Meet or Does Not Meet) will be included in the program if the other criteria listed below is met. The GE should be current or not more than 2 months delayed.
2. Teacher recommendation: If any teacher feels that their student will be best served by being a part of this program, even if they are consistently meeting the standards, that teacher(s) can recommend that their student be included.
3. Parent recommendation: Any parents who feel that their children would be best served by being in this program can request that their child be included.

Criteria for Exit from the Title 1 Program in Hendricks Public Schools for the School Year 2017-2018

1. When a student is in this program, testing will be done regularly. If a student reaches the “Meet” range consistently at a level above the lower 25% of the category, they can exit the program as long as there is a consensus between the Title 1 instructor, classroom teacher, parents and administration. By consistently, it would mean that 3 out of 4 tests given approximately once a month all meet standards at the upper 75% of that category. GE should be current (8th grader in 4th month of school should be at a GE 8.4)
